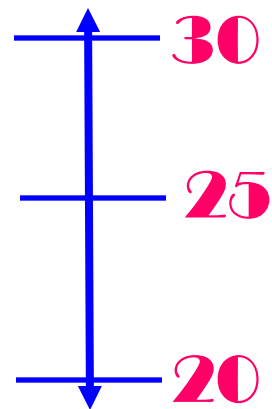

Capacity



***** The amount of liquid a container can hold. Also known as Liquid Volume.**

Gram (g)



1 gram

***** A metric unit for
measuring mass.**

Kilogram (kg)



1 kilogram

*****A metric for unit
measuring mass.**

Liquid Volume



***** The amount of liquid a container can hold. Also known as Capacity.**

Liter (L)



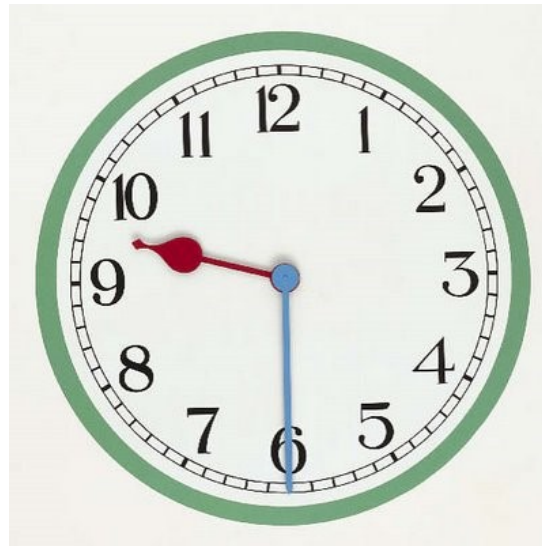
1 liter

***** A clock that has both hour and minute hands.**

Milliliter (mL)

Interval



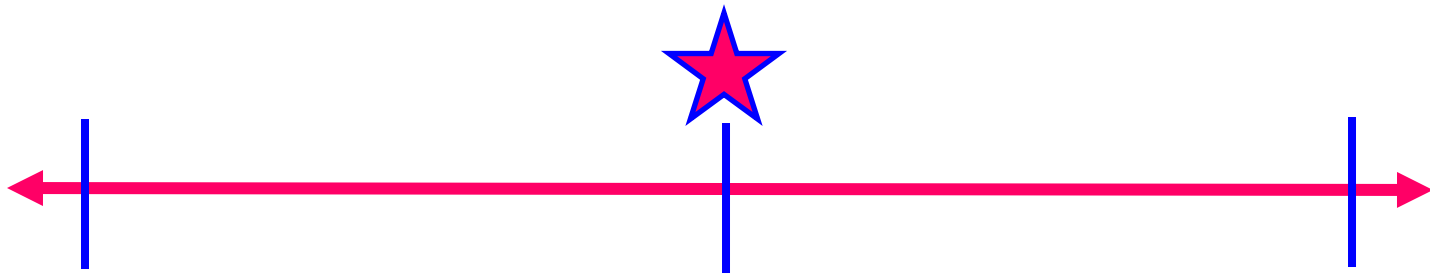
Start



End

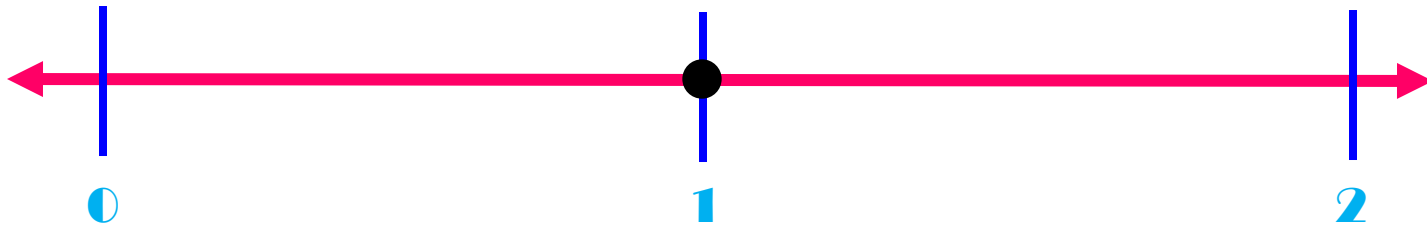
***** The time that passes from the start of an activity until the end of an activity.**

Halfway



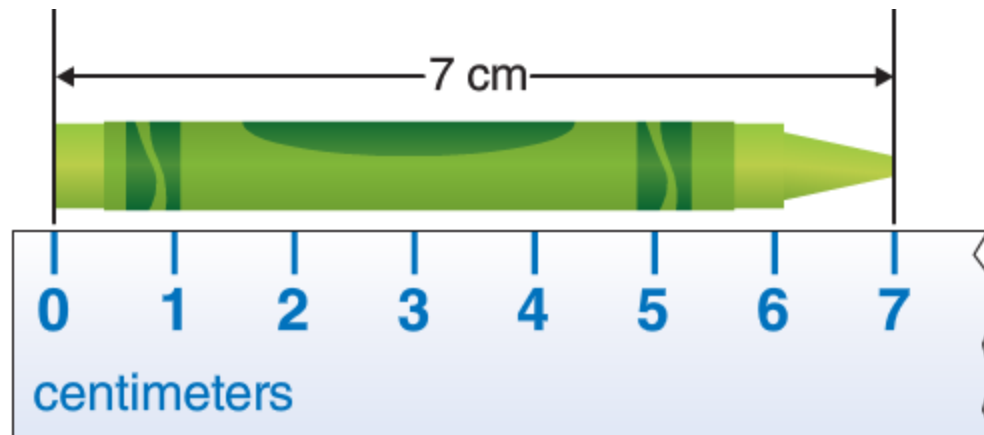
***** The middle point
